City Auditor James Brownlee advised he researched the questions from the last Budget Meeting and provided the following:


- There have been no complaints on mosquitoes.

The Health & Sanitation Expenditure Budget and Revenue Budget were reviewed.

The Sewer and Water Operating Expenditure Budget and Revenue Budget were reviewed. Assistant Public Works Director Chris Brungardt appeared before the Commission.

City Auditor James Brownlee advised the Preliminary Budget will be approved at the August 29, 2011 City Commission meeting and a Public Hearing date set.
