## Give a Little: How Your Small Donations Can Transform Our World

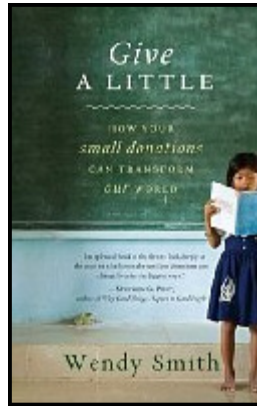
