Toad Cottages and Shooting Stars: Grandma's Bag of Tricks

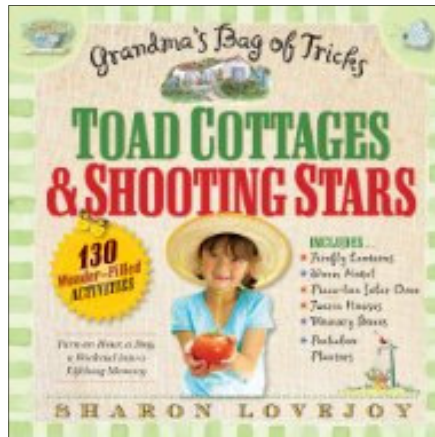

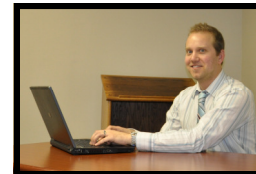
