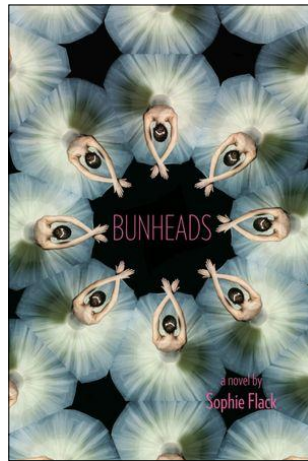

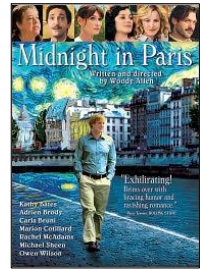


Coffee Arrives in Early February!
