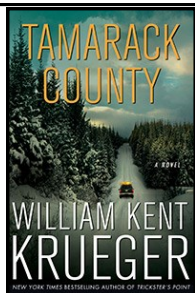

*Tamarack County* is the thirteenth novel in William Kent Krueger's series about private investigator and former sheriff Cork O'Connor. In the dark, cold and stormy days preceding Christmas in the North woods of Minnesota, seemingly unrelated acts of violence are taking place at an alarming rate. When Cork's son, Stephen, and his friend Marlee are run off the road and through the ice on Iron Lake things take a much more personal turn. As speculation increases about possible connections between these events, Cork's daughter, Annie, comes home early for her Christmas visit with unanswered questions of her own. If you are a fan of the O'Connor family, you will enjoy the way they continue to grow and change. If you are new to William Kent Krueger, there are enough glimpses of the past for the story to be satisfying as a first novel. The characters are well developed, there are enough twists to keep the reader guessing and enough suspense to make it impossible to put down.

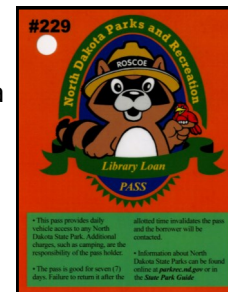

## Check Out a Pass and Check Out a Park

The North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department and the North Dakota State Library are teaming up to offer a new resource for checkout at North Dakota public libraries. It is now possible to check out a state park pass which allows free entrance to any North Dakota State Park. The following guidelines apply to the passes:

- The lending period for each pass is 7 days
- There is a limit of 1 pass per household
- Passes can be checked out by cardholders age 18 and older with no outstanding fines or overdues
- Pass loans can be renewed after the 7 day checkout if there is no one waiting in line to use the pass
- At the end of the loan period, the pass must be returned to the West Fargo Public Library
- The pass provides entry to any North Dakota State Park; any additional charges such as camping and rentals are not included in the pass and are the responsibility of the pass holder



Passes are available for checkout at the Service Desk.
