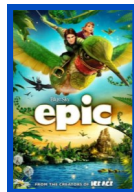

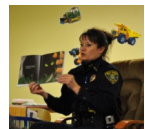

Homework Center

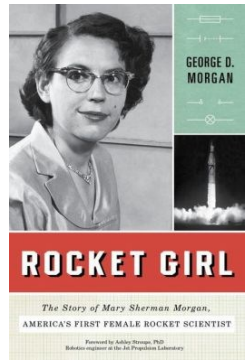
Monday-Thursday 3:00-5:30.

Mary's humble beginnings led her to become the only female among 900 rocket scientists where she played a key role in getting America's first satellite into space. New Technology Combo in Historical Center

Attention researchers: the Historical Center now features a computer connected to the microfilm reader and the scanner. This combination makes it not only possible, but easy to download newspaper pages from the microfilm reader and images from the scanner to the laptop. You can save these to your USB thumb drive or a CD and work with them on your computer at home. CDs are available for purchase at the Service Desk.



iPads @ the Library!

The Library iPads have recently been updated to iOS7 and there are 40 apps to choose from. One we particularly recommend is Zinio. Zinio allows patrons to download and read dozens of popular magazines here in the Library or on your computer or mobile device at home. iPads are available for checkout (90 minutes) for use in the Library by patrons who are 18 or older, have had a card for at least three months, have no overdue materials or fines and whose photo ID matches our records.
