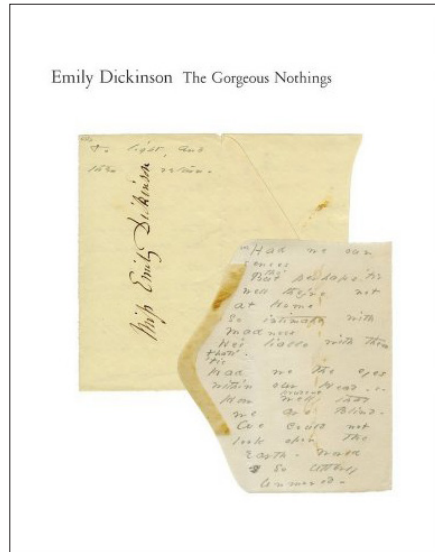

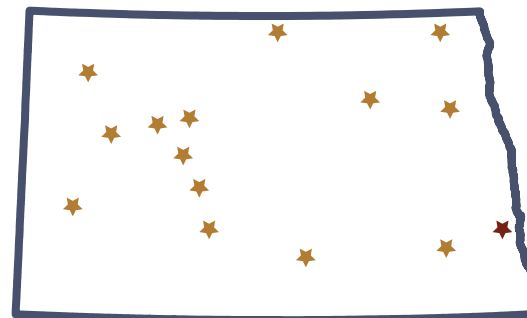

Simply sign into Library2Go using your library card number and your last name for the PIN, the site features an easy-to-use 1-click checkout system. Finally, many of our ebooks now have a no download option—any book that comes in the "Overdrive Read" format can be checked out and read right in your web browser. No need to download anything or sign up for any additional accounts, just checkout and start reading! You can also use Zinio to enjoy magazines on the go or check out Tumble Books for children. State Parks Passes Available for Loan

We are excited to announce that the West Fargo Public Library has been added to the State Park Pass Library Loan Program. This program allows patrons to check out a pass that waives the \$5 daily pass fee to any

North Dakota state park. Passes can be checked out by any library card holder, 18 and older, for 7 days with a 1 per household limit. The pass provides entry into any ND state park and any additional charges, such as camping or rentals, are not included in the pass and will be the responsibility of the pass holder. If you have any questions or are interested in checking out a state park pass, visit us at the library service desk.
