Knitty Giddy -All Tuesdays @ 6:30

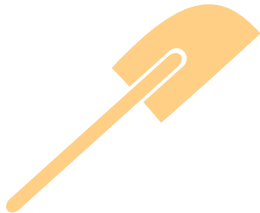
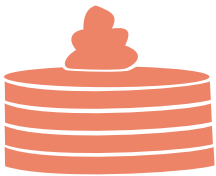
This group invites adults who like to crochet or knit to join anytime! Bring your own supplies. Help for new crafters or those who need a refresher.

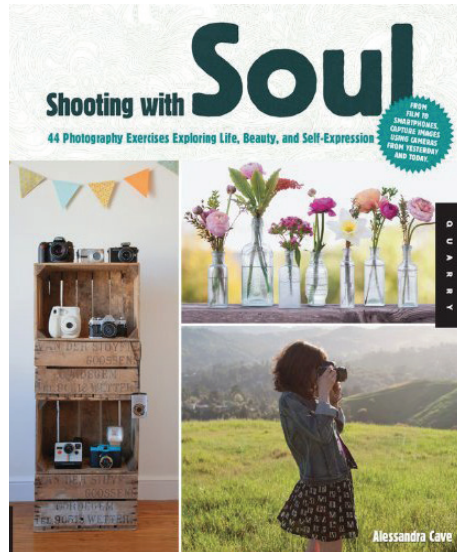
