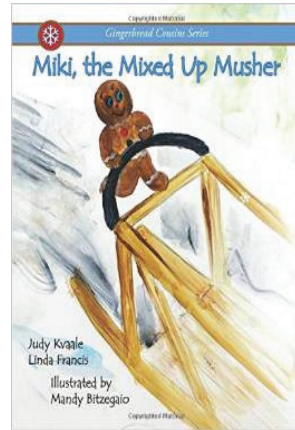


Homework Center - Mondays through Thursdays @ 3:00-5:30 PM

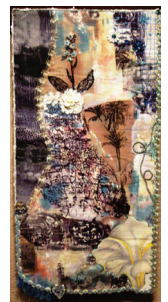


September Hours
