Ham Radio – Wednesdays @ 7:00 PM – April 8-May 13

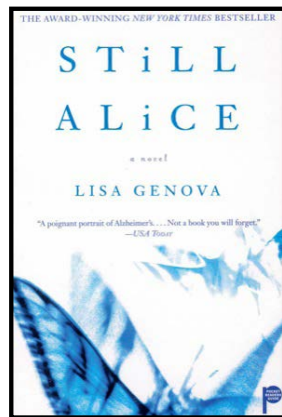
Ham Radio sessions are open to all adults and children (with attending adult) who want to learn more about ham radio operation.

The Lorax Celebration! – Thursday, April 23 @ 6:30-8:00 PM

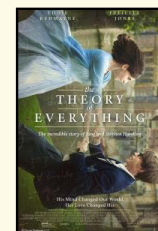

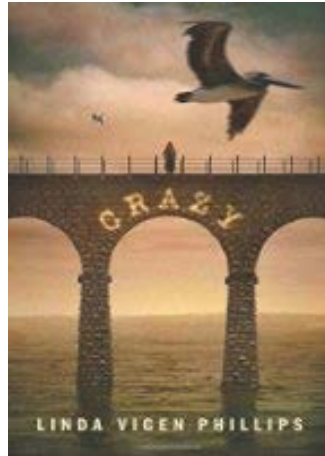
Homework help and a free afterschool snack. No registration required. The Homework Center is not open on April 6 when school is on break.

Reader's Corner

Crazy by Linda Vigen Phillips

From the back cover: "Laura is a typical fifteen-year-old growing up in the 1960s, navigating her way through classes, friendships, and even a new romance. But she's carrying around a secret: her mother is mentally ill." The family won't talk about her mother's illness and Laura finds comfort in her art, until her mother, also an artist, has a breakdown which starts Laura worrying that she'll turn out just like her mother.



Crazy creates a vivid picture of Laura's confusion in dealing with her mother's illness, her own conflicting feelings, and the everyday troubles of a teenager. The well-written free verse poetry reads as easily as prose and the style creates a feeling of seeing snapshots of daily life.
