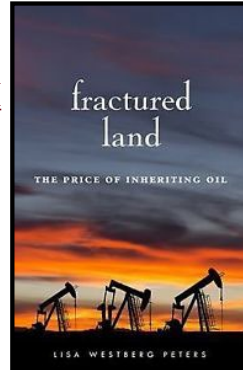

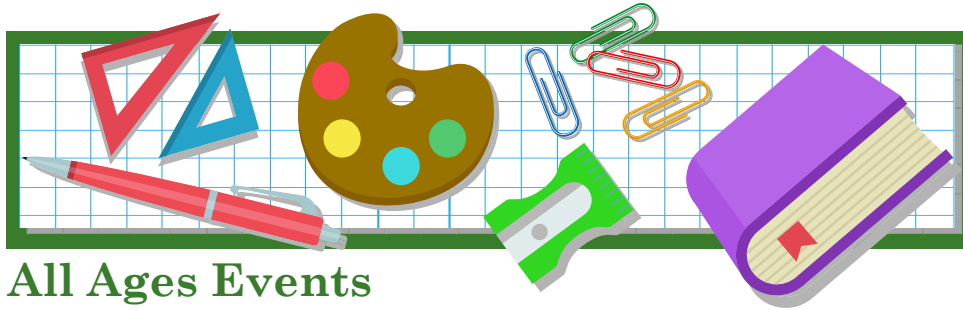
Teacups Book Club – Monday, August 10 @ 7:00 PM

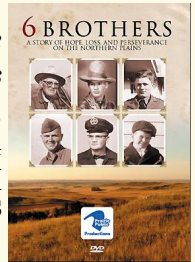

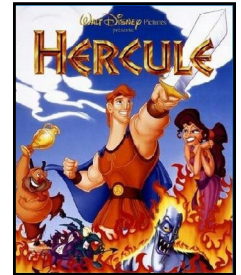

The Land of Stories: The Wishing Spell by Chris Colfer

“Once upon a time... These are the most magical words our world has ever known and the gateway into the greatest stories ever told” begins the charming tale of *The Wishing Spell*. On their 12th birthday, twins Alex and Connor were given a book of fairy tales. They soon realize this is not a normal book, as they fall into the Land of Stories with seemingly no way out. Desperate, they begin a journey to collect the eight items necessary for the wishing spell, their only chance to get home. As they set out, they encounter classic fairy tale characters, mermaids, trolls, and the Big Bad Wolf Pack sent by the Evil Queen. Colfer creates a fun, magical tale that engages readers in the wonders of fairy tales. Alex and Connor’s story continues in *The Enchantress Returns*, *A Grimm Warning*, and the newly released *The Land of Stories: Beyond the Kingdoms*.

Land in Her Own Name: Women as Homesteaders in ND

Thousands of women took advantage of the Homestead Act (1862) that offered free land in the Great Plains. This Historical Center exhibit features 24 panels from H. Elaine Lindgren’s book depicting the lives of women homesteaders across ND, along with information about Amelia Froemke who homesteaded land in what is now the heart of West Fargo, and a display of vintage items the pioneers might have used. Located in the upstairs corridor of the library. Free of charge and open to the public until September 19th. Enjoy!
