### It's Coloring Time! – December 28-January 13

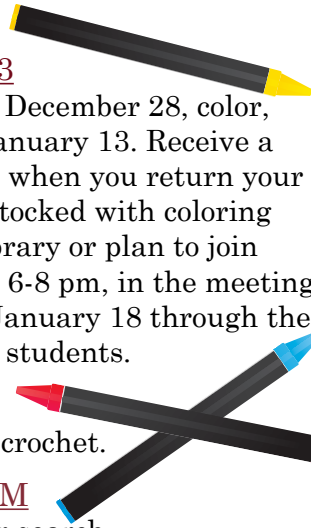
