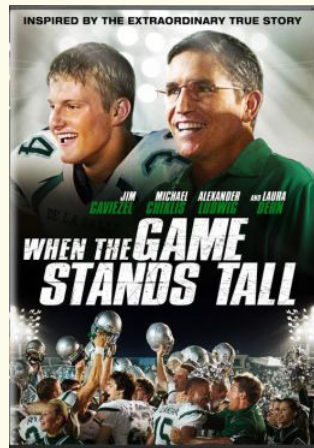

## Tax Forms and Tax Help

Tax forms will be made available as soon as they arrive. Due to budget cuts, the IRS will provide only a limited selection of printed forms and instructions - instructions for 1040, 1040A, and 1040EZ are not available. Forms and instructions can be printed from any public computer (\$.10/page). Ask at the Service Desk if you need help locating your form or instructions on the IRS or North Dakota webpages. ## Metro Arts Pass

Starting in February, The Arts Partnership, Fargo Public Library, Moorhead Public Library, and West Fargo Public Library will launch a new service for metro area residents. West Fargo Public Library cardholders will be able to visit local arts and cultural organizations at no or reduced costs through the Metro Arts Pass program (<http://theartspartnership.net/metro-arts-pass>).
