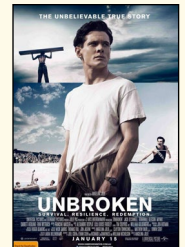

## New Historical Center Exhibit

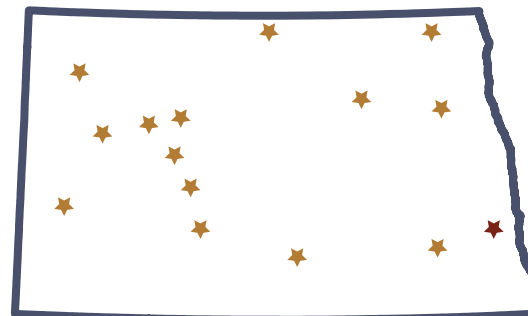
*Land in Her Own Name: Women as Homesteaders in ND display*

Thousands of women took advantage of the Homestead Act (1862) that offered free land in the Great Plains. The exhibit features 24 panels from H. Elaine Lindgren's book depicting the lives of women homesteaders across ND, along with information about Amelia Froemke who homesteaded land in what is now the heart of West Fargo, and a display of vintage items the pioneers might have used. Located in the upstairs corridor of the library. Free of charge and open to the public. Enjoy!
