Beasts of Olympus Series by Lucy Coats

Have a young reader looking for a great book? Check out the Beasts of Olympus series by Lucy Coats. This hilarious new series is perfect for middle grade readers in search of a fun and exciting world, which may be both familiar and entirely turned around. Set in Ancient Greece, Beasts of Olympus follows Pandemonius -- otherwise known as Demon—the son of the god Pan. Demon is taken from his quiet life in a small village to the Stables of the Gods on Olympus, where he becomes the Beast Keeper. Demon quickly learns that this will not be an easy job. He must first learn how to tame the creatures, how to heal them, and then how to clean up after them (which is no effortless task). Infused with the art of Brett Bean, this exciting chapter book series is perfect for new readers to tackle by themselves or for reading aloud together. The first three books are available now, with more titles arriving this spring!
