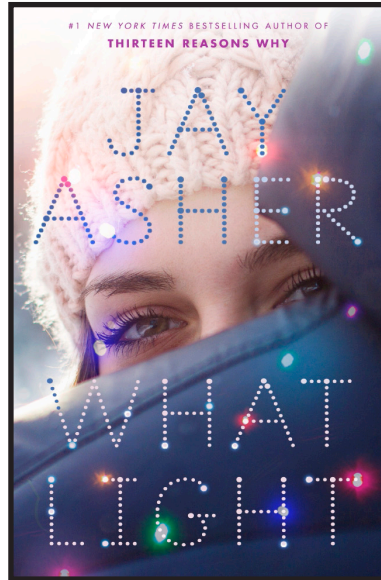


Reader's Corner

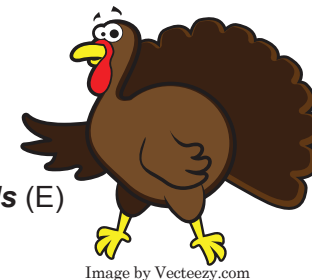
