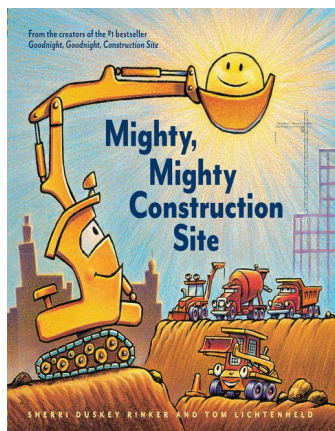

State Parks Passes Available for Loan

Summer is a great time to enjoy North Dakota's beautiful state parks, and our State Park Pass Program makes it easier – and cheaper – than ever! Patrons can check out a pass that waives the \$5 daily vehicle entrance fee to any North Dakota state park. Passes can be checked out by any West Fargo library card holder, 18 and older, for up to one week; no renewals. This offer is limited to 1 pass per household at any time. Any additional charges, such as camping or rentals, are not included in the pass and will be the responsibility of the pass holder.
