Mahjong Game Day – Tuesdays @ 1:30 PM

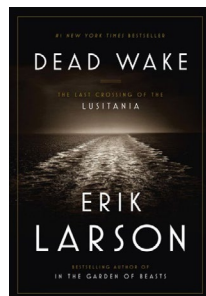
Beginner and experienced players are welcome to join this group of enthusiasts who play Mahjong every Tuesday afternoon. No registration. Free.

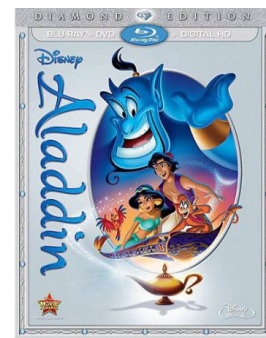
